



- "Talent Now" is led by a consortium of six large and medium size biopharmaceucticals partners: UCB, Janssen, GSK, Thermo Fischer, Univercells and Takeda
- The group works in close collaboration with key stakeholders in the Walloon ecosystem: FOREM, essenscia and key education providers
