## Eligibility criteria



- Consortium composition: at least 4 partners (2 companies including at least 1 SME + 2 research units)
- 1 leading company whose headquarters are located in Wallonia
- 1 research unit (university, research center, high school) settled in « Fédération Wallonie-Bruxelles » (FWB)
- The 2 other partners may be outside Wallonia/FWB but will not be subsidised by the Region.
- Financial health: companies must not be in financial difficulties according to european definition
- Real partnership: Shared R&D and shared exploitation of the results
- Innovation: Technological or not-technological, a product/service/process may be concerned
- **Project**: Proof of concept (POC) or prototype within 6 years after the begining of the project
- Duration: min 2 years; max 4 years; Budget ideally between 1 and 4 Mios €



- The cluster guarantees the technological validity of the project and ensures that its internal strategy is respected
- The administration verifies the eligibility of the project and validates the techno-scientific analysis
- The Walloon Government Jury validates the coherence of the project with the philosophy of the competitiveness clusters policy and evaluates the opportunity for public support

These roles are complementary and each is necessary for the smooth running of the overall process of setting up, selecting and labelling projects.



## Leader/consortium

Presentation of the main lines of the project

#### BioWin

- Verification that the consortium has a clear understanding of what is required in a proposal
- Identification of any missing skills
- Presentation of the overall support process and the evaluation steps (maturity assessment / BioWin's Internal Selection Committee (CSI) / analysis and opinion of the Administration / Jury of the Walloon Government)

## **Post meeting**

Communication of information and provision of the templates for the next steps

## Writing / Submission of the Pre-project



## Leader/consortium

 Elaboration of a more advanced version of the project according to the template and the instructions provided by the cluster.

### BioWin

- Revision of a the pre-project, recommendations on critical points
- Activation of the network if one or more partners are missing
- Postponement to the next call if the pre-project is immature

The pre-project must allow a rapid and immediate understanding of the project's purpose, its originality, its impact on employment and regional economic development as well as the contribution and distribution of roles between the project partners

- Validation of the pre-project according to the cluster's criteria
- > Submission of the pre-project to the Walloon Region

### SPW-EER

Ruling: Eligibility, first financial analysis and research qualification (IR/ED)

## BioWin & Experts appointed by the cluster

- Expertise and exchanges on critical points (scientific, technical, innovation aspects) in order to consolidate the proposal
  - SPW-EER : Minutes of the Ruling
  - ➤ BioWin: Summary report with recommendations and comments on the decision to continue, postpone or redirect the dossier. The consortium agreement template is provided to the leader of the project.

## Writing / Submission of the proposal to BioWin



## Leader/consortium

 Complete version of the project, written according to the template provided by the cluster and intended for BioWin's Internal Selection Committee (CSI)

#### BioWin

- Verification of the adequacy between the content and the requirements of the template
- Verification that the recommendations made during the maturity assessment have been taken into account
- Verification of the progress made on the consortium agreement

## Post meeting:

- Either: submission of the proposal to the experts appointed by the cluster (CSI)
- Or: postponement to the next call if the proposal is incomplete and/or of insufficient quality

## Evaluation by the experts of BioWin



#### Consortium

- 15 min presentation followed by Q/A, duration: ~1h
- Attendance of the CEO from the coordinating company required
- Attendance of a representative for each partner preferable

## Internal Selection Committee (CSI)

Evaluation of the proposal, according to evaluation criteria by a panel of experts appointed by BioWin.
 Each proposal is examined by 2 experts along with the President of the Jury

### BioWin and SPW-EER

Observer role

## **Post evaluation:**

- Within 5 working days: minutes and decision wether the proposal should be submitted (or not) to the Wallon Region with possible minor adaptations
- Possibility to submit the proposal to the next call if major adaptations must be implemented

## Submission of the proposal to the Walloon Region



#### Consortium

- Final formatting of the form taking into account all recommandations made during the various stages of the process
- Finalisation of all the required annexes in the requested format
- Finalisation and signature of the consortium agreement by all partners

### BioWin

- Writing of the BioWin opinion on the project for the Jury of the Walloon Government
- Signature of the consortium agreement
- Compilation of the full proposal
- Submission of the final proposal on the extranet of the Walloon Region

Official submission of the proposal for examination by the SPW and the Jury of the Walloon Government



## Labelling, financial agreement and project start

#### Walloon Governement

Formal decision on the commitment to finance the project

#### SPW-EER

Writing and signature of the financial agreement containing the task details, the objectives and the
planning of the project, a well as budget details relating to each partner. The financial agreement must be
finalised within 12 weeks after project labelling.

Project start, kick-off meeting

## Success fee



Is your project labeled by the Walloon Governement?

The clusters are engaged in a progressive self-financing mechanism and apply a success fee of 2% on the subsidies allocated to Walloon industrial partners

## **Terms and conditions**

A service agreement is established between BioWin and each industrial partner.

The success fee is calculated based on the financing agreement and is paid to the cluster in two installments:

- -65% of the amount when the working capital is received by the partners
- -35% at mid-term
